



RE: INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WISHING TO RE-REGISTER FOR 2017- 2018 SCHOOL YEAR

The Calgary Board of Education would like to take this opportunity to thank you for studying with us and we trust that your school year has been enjoyable.

According to our records, your program with the Calgary Board of Education will soon be over. If you are planning to continue, you need to pay for the next school year. Once you have paid, we will give you a new letter of acceptance which you can use to renew your study permit.

HEALTH INSURANCE

All international students must have health insurance.

If you are a returning student and now have Alberta Health Care (AHC - Alberta's provincial health care plan), you can get a policy that is an extension to AHC. This is the extended insurance coverage policy. **Please note: The extended insurance coverage is only available to returning students who have Alberta Health Care, and does not apply to new students.

Sample Alberta Health Care Card

If you have Alberta Health Care coverage, your coverage card will look like this:



In order to be eligible for the extended health insurance coverage policy, we need to see your Alberta Health Care card at the time of re-registration and will need the completed Extended Insurance Form (page 4 of this document) submitted at the same time.

PAYMENT

Payment can be made to the Global Learning office (refer to letterhead for address and contact information) by any of the following:

1. From Outside Canada:

STUDY PERMIT RENEWAL

According to Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC):

Only some people can charge a fee or receive any other type of payment to represent or advise you on a Canadian immigration proceeding or application. These are:

- *lawyers and paralegals who are members in good standing of a Canadian provincial or territorial law society,*
- *immigration consultants who are members in good standing of the Immigration Consultants of Canada Regulatory Council.*

*These people are called “authorized” representatives. CIC will not deal with representatives who charge for their services **and** are not members of one of the above groups.*

As we do receive fees from you, we cannot assist you with renewing your study permit. The same situation applies to the staff at Canada Homestay Network.

If you have strong English skills and follow the instructions very carefully, you may be able to apply directly using the online application process (<http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/applications/extend-student.asp>).

However, you may want to consider hiring a **Certified Immigration Consultant** to assist you. There is a fee for this service which you may consider to be worth paying



for the peace of mind in ensuring your application is done accurately and help you avoid delays or even a rejection of your application.

REFUND POLICY

If:

- **Your Study Permit is denied:** You will receive a full tuition refund (less a \$250 refund fee). A copy of the rejection letter must be submitted with the refund request.
- **Your immigration status changes:** You will receive a full tuition refund (less a \$250 refund fee) if parent's immigration status changes and meets the criteria outlined in CBE's Administrative Regulation 3017A. Proof must be presented to Kingsland Centre (7430 - 5 Street S.W, telephone: 403-777-7373) prior to the last business day of September of the current school year. After that date, no refund will be given under any circumstances.
- **You cannot attend for other reasons:** You will receive two-thirds (2/3) refund of the tuition if you withdraw prior to the commencement of the program as per the Duration of Study (program) dates on the letter of acceptance.
- **You withdraw or are withdrawn from the Calgary Board of Education:** Once classes have begun as per the program dates on your letter of acceptance, no refund will be given (this includes between-semester refunds). There is no refund for a midyear withdrawal.
- **Late arrivals:** When a student arrives late, there will be no refund for the time period missed.

Tuition is refunded by the same method of payment and to the same person who originally paid.
